Administrative Procedure 206: School Attendance Areas

Sturgeon Public Schools has introduced Administrative Procedure 206: School Attendance Areas and Requests to Attend a School Outside of the Designated Attendance Area. This new procedure, along with supporting forms, clarifies processes for non-resident and School of Choice enrolment requests. Developed to support school leaders and align with the Education Act, this procedure ensures transparency while balancing parent choice and the Division's commitment to resident student success.
