## Labour Action Update: February 21/2025

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As a follow-up to our February 14, 2025, letter, we are providing an update on our ongoing negotiations with CUPE Local 4625. Unfortunately, negotiations have reached an impasse, and CUPE National has not shown a willingness to engage in finding a fair and sustainable resolution. Despite the Division's efforts to reach an agreement, significant gaps remain between the proposals. ## Potential School Amalgamation: Update

Sturgeon Public Schools is committed to keeping families informed about the proposed amalgamation of Gibbons School and Landing Trail School into a new K-9 school. Following the Board of Trustees' October 23 motion to initiate the school closure process, administration has been engaging with the community to gather feedback.

A public information session was held on December 3, 2024, where families and stakeholders had the opportunity to learn more and share their thoughts. Nearly 50 community members and 325 students provided input, with feedback showing strong engagement and common themes in hopes, concerns, and programming considerations.
